

## Fats, Oils, and Greases

### They gum up the works!



greases (FOG) wreak havoc on systems. When FOGs are rinsed down the drain (even when using a garbage disposal), they build up and harden, causing sewer pipes to clog. Keep our water flowing by properly disposing of FOGs.

#### Properly dispose of fats, oils, and greases (FOG)

Put FOG in covered containers and cans for proper disposal. Wipe down pots and pans with a towel to remove any FOG. Scrape food and scraps into the trash when possible.




# "Flushable" Wipes?

Keep our wastewater system
flowing and
dispose of these
items in the trash.
