ITEM 5: FINANCIAL REPORT

Connie Ozinga, Library Director, submitted the March 2019 Statistics and the Revenue and Expenditure Reports for the period ending March 31, 2019. We have spent 18.6% of the budget so far this year.

The Friends of the Library made \$6,496.70 from the book sale.

A check for \$250.00 was received from the Lions Club. A name plate donated by Wixom Lions Club will be presented to the library.

ITEM 6: LIBRARY DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Art Show: Next month's meeting will be the evening of the reception for the Walled Lake Schools Art Show.

Summer Reading Club kicks off June 15, 2019. The theme is "A Universe of Stories", which is meant to be a space theme. The HVCA Art Fair will also be on the grounds as they were last year. There will be pony rides and a petting farm. The Summer Reading Club prizes have started to arrive at the library.

We will be a drop off location for the Lakes Area Women's Club Diaper Drive beginning April 29, 2019.

Book Club Kits are now available for checkout. Each bag contains six copies of a book, author info, and suggested book club questions.

The coat racks for the Youth Section have been moved to another location to allow for the children's self-checkout display.

A new part time employee will begin work on May 1, 2019. She will take the place of one of our employees who will not return from maternity leave because she accepted a job at the Plymouth Library with benefits and fewer hours.

Discussion on "fine free libraries" is ongoing. This is where you will no longer receive a daily late fine on overdue items. You are still responsible for returning your items and will be charged the cost of the book if you do not return them. The following libraries are
