ITEM 6: ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

a. Director's Report

Library Director Lobert:

Dolly Parton's Imagination Library continues to generate excitement in the community, though the pace of registrations has decreased significantly. There are 43 more active children registered than last month. As of Friday, February 18, 2022, there are 484 active children registered for Commerce Township's Imagination Library. An additional 11 registered children turned five and graduated from the program in the first month.

At the February 8, 2022 Commerce Township Board of Trustees meeting, the Board of Trustees voted to approve both ballot language for a millage renewal as well as placing the millage on ballot for the August, 2022 election. I have included the resolution for your review.

The proposed programming policy, approved by the Library Advisory Board in January, was forwarded to the Township's attorney. The attorney's review is not yet complete.

COVID quarantine continues to impact staffing; staff members were quarantined for 17 days over the last month.

Commerce Township Community Library, Wixom Public Library and Walled Lake City Library have collaborated with Walled Lake Consolidated Schools to hold a student library card drive. Through mid-March, virtual card registration will be publicized weekly in the WLCSD e-newsletter. CTCL has issued 114 student cards as of February 17, 2022. We are pleased with how this partnership has worked and we look forward to running similar library card drives in the future.

Commerce Township Community Library closed early, at 5:00 pm, on February 17, 2022 due to poor weather. The Library was also closed due to inclement weather on February 2, 2022.

Congratulations to librarian Anjel Lyman on her new position! Anjel will be transitioning from serving as a part-time Adult Services Librarian to the vacant Teen Services Librarian position. Anjel has been a mainstay at CTCL for the last 17 years, as a patron, as the first Teen Advisory Board member, as a volunteer, a library page and a part-time librarian. An internal candidate, Brannon McCullough, will be the part-time Adult Services Librarian.

With the additional demand for the White Pine and Dodge rooms, we have encountered a handful of instances where the existing policy is not clear or does not adequately reflect the restrictions to and responsibilities of the room renter. She is drafting updates to the Meeting Room Policy and is asking for the Board's input on issues such as renting to businesses, political functions/fundraiser and rental fees. Discussion followed. Library Director Lobert will bring a draft policy back to the Board for review.

- The sidewalk project at the Richardson Center was approved. The sidewalk will go around the back of the building to the patio and the "kayak launch".

- Prime 7 at 8635 Cooley Lake Road was approved for light entertainment (acoustical instrument) inside the building.
- Jay James, Building Official is working on a rental inspection program.
- The Township Board is in support of moving forward with a study on the Union Lake Road traffic congestion.
- The Library Millage approved with the levy of 0.6601 of one mill for a period of 10 years.
