ITEM 2: 2019 TOWNSHIP BUDGET

The board began with the Maintenance Department budget. Discussion on the pros and cons of possibly having a contracted company for lawn cutting and landscaping needs and what it would do to staffing of the department.

Trustee Sovel stated an RFP should be done for a property maintenance company if that is the route that is chosen for lawn services.

Supervisor Scott stated there needs to be one person in this department who is "on call" evenings and weekends.

The board discussed with Mark Schoder his needs for staffing, what he needs for summer help and the Capitaly Outlay items presented in the budget.

The board went over the Cemetery Budget next. There is a need for new fencing at most of the cemeteries whether it be all around or just part of it. There are a lot of dead trees that could pose a threat to headstones at three cemeteries. The board recommended setting aside more funds to put toward stone preservation as in the past.

Road Improvement Fund was discussed. Trustee Sovel stated that the fund balance is so large because the township has been saving for years for large projects. We can use money from this to fund Tri-Party projects. Supervisor Scott would like \$100k to come from the General Fund to Road Improvement Fund be used for Tri-Party.

The board briefly discussed Budget Stabilization Fund, Museum Fund and Debt Sinking Fund. While there are still parts of the budget that need to be discussed, such as Water, Sewer and General fund, Supervisor Scott believes we are moving forward to approving the budget.
