Procedure for public comment by electronic means:

Under Executive Order 2020-129, there must be full opportunity for both the general public and the members of the Planning Commission to hear and be heard at appropriate times during the meeting. Public participants will be muted upon entry to the meeting, but will have a chance to speak during public comment and during scheduled public hearings.

Once connected to the meeting, members of the public wishing to participate in the virtual public comment must alert us that they wish to speak by pressing *9 on their telephone's keypad. Pressing *9 will activate the "Raise Hand" feature signaling to us that you wish to comment. Because of limitations with muting and unmuting members of the public, there will only be one public comment period near the top of each meeting's agenda, which will be announced by the Chairperson or meeting moderator at the appropriate time. If a public hearing is scheduled for a specific agenda item, the Chairperson will open the public hearing at which time there will be an opportunity to press *9 to speak during the public hearing. Participants will be called on one at a time, as would happen during an in-person meeting. When you are unmuted, please introduce yourself by stating your name and address for the record. You will then have approx. two (2) minutes to share your comments with the Planning Commission, as would happen during an in-person meeting. At the conclusion of your comments or your two (2) minutes, you will be muted and removed from the public comment public comment queue. Participants may also choose to submit written comments that will be read into the record during public comment by the Planning Commission Chairperson, or by the Planning Department staff. Written comments must include a full name and address; anonymous comments will not be read into the record.
